

# **NEWN Membership Levels**

### **N-EWN PARTNER**

Partners typically engage at an organizational level rather than as an individual due to high-level of expected engagement. Partners should engage in a minimum of 3 to 4 activities each year and provide a summary of those activities for the N-EWN Annual Report. Partners may also choose to select one representative to serve on the N-EWN advisory committee (see the governance document for more information on this committee). Organizations interested in becoming a N-EWN Partner should submit a membership inquiry to the N-EWN Operations Committee. Interested parties are also encouraged to communicate with existing N-EWN partners about their potential role within N-EWN and seek recommendation from an existing partner. Partner requests will be reviewed by the N-EWN Operations Committee and submitted to the Executive Committee. Interested organizations will also be asked to submit a letter of interest. Admission will be decided by the Executive Committee. The path to becoming a N-EWN Partner typically takes 3-6 months. If accepted, a welcome letter and N-EWN certificate will be provided. Partner membership to N-EWN will be reviewed and, if applicable, renewed every two years or at the discretion of the Executive Committee.

#### **N-EWN COLLABORATOR**

Collaborators are individuals who wish to collaborate on or contribute to a specific project or research topic with an existing N-EWN partner. These types of relationships occur ad hoc and are at the discretion of the project lead and the N-EWN Operations Committee. No letter of interest is needed to become a collaborator. Please reach out directly to the N-EWN researcher that you wish to collaborate with or reach out to a member of the N-EWN Operations Committee for more information.

#### **N-EWN STAKEHOLDER**

Organizations and individuals interested in becoming stakeholders can contact the Operations Committee through the N-EWN website to join the newsletter and email distribution list, which will include opportunities to attend webinars, information about the latest N-EWN research, and other ways to stay abreast of the latest in the EWN field.






## **Become a NEWN Member**
